PRESIDENT'S REPORT

As this issue of our Winter Hawk Talk goes to print several of our teams are preparing for this weekend's semi finals. Congratulations to our B1, B3, U14 Black Hawks and U14 Falcon Hawks who will all be playing in these Semis. We have been fortunate this winter that the weather has been much more cooperative than in previous seasons and we have not lost too many Saturdays. Commiserations must go to those teams which missed out.

A huge thank you to all those team coaches and managers who got the boys organized. I realize the older teams looked after themselves but we had several junior teams this winter who trained regularly even on those cold evenings when our seniors stayed indoors. Once again thanks to Garry Walker and Mike Whitney who did all the initial setting up and raced around every weekend making sure things ran smoothly.

SUMMER WAREHOUSE

Two weeks ago the club held their AGM. Garry Walker who has been a long time stalwart of the Hawks has decided to stand down from some of his roles as Warehouse Coordinator. On behalf of the Committee and of the many players who have played Warehouse over the past ten or so years, I would like to thank Gaz for all his dedicated service. We all know that he will still be a tireless worker but systems have been put in to place to lighten his work load because we all want to see him and Razor around for many years yet.

Eddie Mills has agreed to take on the role of Warehouse Registrar. My own boys are now both playing Warehouse so I will be able to assist in a Sub-committee which will look after team registration and liaising with the Warehouse Association. Garry will coordinate stats and I know he will be on hand to offer assistance based on his vast experience. Once we have organized teams, it will be necessary for the captains and their management to organize the weekly collection of match fees, getting players, paying ground fees etc. for their own teams. Garry spent many stressful hours racing after teams who should have been capable of doing these tasks prior to game days. Over the past winter, most of our Senior teams did this and that certainly took the pressure off Garry.

As most of you would be aware the association which runs our complex has experienced major financial difficulties over the past twelve months. Independent auditors have put in to place sweeping strategies to overhaul the financial running of all the clubs concerned. One of the findings was that none of the clubs has been paying enough for general running of the complex. All of our fees have been increased. We now have to pay private contractors for mowing. This has a huge impact on us as we are predominantly a summer user when the grass grows much quicker and we require more regular mowing. Electricity charges are going to increase as well. Due to all of these increases the club will need to increase registration fees for both juniors and seniors. We are currently assessing the costs that will be associated with Warehouse for the summer season and we will endeavour to keep the increases as low as possible for each player.

The payment of home ground fees which we introduced during winter will be needed in summer as well to help the club meet its increased costs.

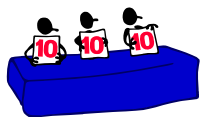

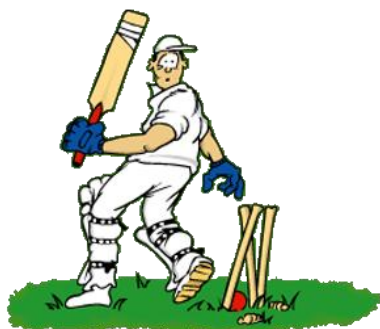

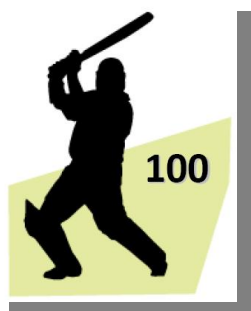
